

Remember my chains (Colossians 4 v 18)



HYEUN-SOO LIM (NORTH KOREA)

Hyeun-soo Lim (60) is a Canadian pastor who grew up in South Korea. He was arrested in January 2015 while on an aid mission to North Korea. In December 2015 he was sentenced to life in prison with hard labour.



YANG RONGLI (CHINA)

Yang Rongli (56) was arrested in September 2009 because she organised a huge prayer rally after police raided the church that she led and destroyed its building. Pastor Yang was sentenced to seven years in prison.



TOHAR HAYDAROV (UZBEKISTAN)

Tohar Haydarov (32) is from Tashkent. He was born Muslim, but became a Christian and is serving a ten-year sentence on false charges. Tohar suffers from back pain and hopes for an early release during 2016.



MARYAM ZARGARAN (IRAN)

Maryam Zargarán (37) is a member of a house church in Tehran. In 2013, Maryam was sentenced to four years in prison. She has many health problems including heart disease, diabetes and arthritis, and is not receiving proper medical treatment.



ASIA BIBI (PAKISTAN)

Asia Bibi (50) is a Christian farm worker. In 2010 she was sentenced to death for blasphemy. In July 2015, the death penalty was suspended, but Asia remains in prison, waiting for her Supreme Court appeal to be heard.



HAILE NAIZGHE (ERITREA)

Rev Haile Naizghe, who is in his fifties, has been imprisoned without trial since 2004. Before his arrest he ran a network of house churches that the government had banned. Rev Haile has not seen his family since he was imprisoned.
