## **TEXT OF PETITION TO IRANIAN AMBASSADOR**

Mr Javad Kachoueian, Ambassador Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran

Your Excellency,

I write, as a member of the Oireachtas, to express my deep concern about the continuing ill-treatment of religious minorities in Iran. I understand that over 300 Christians have been arrested in recent years, according to figures provided by the United Nations Special Rapporteur on Human Rights in Iran.

I am encouraged that since your arrival in Ireland earlier this year, you have said publicly that one of the main goals of the new Iranian government is to remove obstacles and normalise relations with Europe, based on mutual respect and common interest.

I appeal to your government to address the imprisonment of Christians as a matter of urgency as it constitutes an obstacle to normal relations between friendly countries. I particularly appeal for the release of Saeed Abedini, Farshid Fathi and Behnam Irani (three Christian leaders) and Mohammed Ali Dadkhah (a human rights lawyer who has represented Christians) who are all serving long prison sentences.
